

Installing the Distal Limb

1. Insert the CD into the computer's CD drive.
2. Locate the Distal Limb CD on your computer and double click its icon to open it.
3. To install:

Windows Users:

Double click Setup icon to begin installation. An installer will guide you through the installation process. Read and follow the instructions carefully.

Mac Users:

Copy the Distal Limb folder to your hard drive. *(Although the program can be run from the CD, it is highly recommended that you copy the program to the hard drive for best performance.)*

Note to OS9 users: This program will not run under virtual memory. To disable virtual memory, go to the Apple menu item, then to Control Panels, then to Memory. Turn virtual memory off and restart your computer.

4. This program requires Quicktime 5.0.2 or later. If you need to install Quicktime, or you're not sure if you need to install Quicktime, please read the following installation instructions.

Windows Users:

If you do not have Quicktime 5.0.2 or later, the installer will notify you. Install QuickTime 6, included on the CD, after finishing the Distal Limb installation. Locate the fileQuicktimeFullInstaller.exe on the CD and double click its icon to begin installation. Accept all the defaults during the install process.*

Mac Users:

If you see a square with a red X where a movie should be after starting the Distal Limb program, you must install QuickTime 5.0.2 or later. To install simply double click on the QuickTime icon on the CD. Accept all the defaults during the install process.*

*You do not need to register this product (just click "next" when asked to register).

5. To start the program, double click on the Distal Limb icon, located on the desktop or in the folder in which the program was installed.

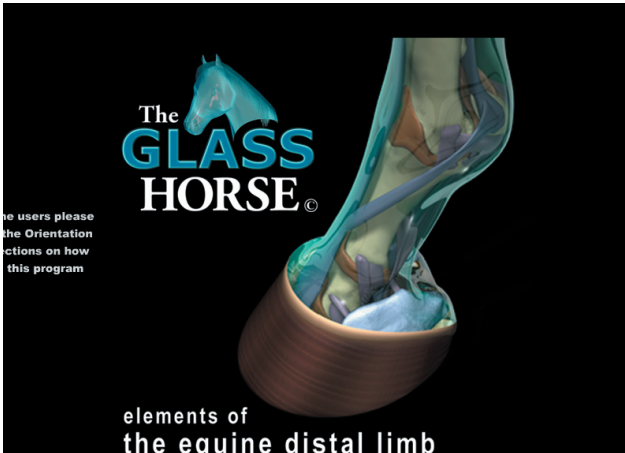


6. The CD must be in the tray for the program to run.

Trouble Shooting

Setting Screen Resolution

Does your screen look like this? Does the program appear to be frozen?



If so, your screen resolution needs to be changed.

First, quit the Distal Limb (you may have to press ESC).

Windows users:

Right click on the desktop. A pop-up menu will appear. Choose properties, then settings. Move the arrow to change the resolution from 800x600 to 1024x768. Click apply, then accept the changes.

Macintosh Users:

OSX: Open system preferences, choose display, and change the resolution to 1024x768.

OS9: Go to the apple menu > control panels > monitors, and change the resolution to 1024x768.

Restart the Distal Limb.
